GitHub for AUTH48

- Goal: To further support the authoring community and facilitate author reviews using tools they are familiar with.
- The RPC offers an optional AUTH48 process where the RPC shares its proposed edits with authors in an RPC-created repo and a pull request made against the approved source file.
- Example repos:

- Relevant parties, including the ADs, are invited to join the repo as contributors. A review cannot easily be assigned to you unless you accept the invitation. Approvals still required via email.

Tools Modernization Effort



Coming soon! (Mid April 2026)

- New document management system that runs on datatracker technology.
- New fast and reader-friendly www.rfc-editor.org.
- New queue subsite for authors with better state and cluster information.
- Improved errata system: triage by RPC first, so spam does not get distributed. Type (editorial or technical) set by RPC or the ADs, not the reporters. Verifiers use datatracker credentials to log in.
- New editing tool with built-in checkers: DraftForge (available at draftforge.ietf.org), a VS Code extension with GitHub integration.
